

# PM CHAIRS 50TH MEETING OF PRAGATI



## Context:

- The Prime Minister chaired the 50th meeting of PRAGATI. PRAGATI (Pro-Active Governance And Timely Implementation)
- It is a **technology-driven governance and monitoring platform** launched by the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) in 2015.

## Aim

To improve public administration and accelerate implementation of government programmes and projects.



## Objectives

### ■ Project Monitoring:

- Track progress of high-value and critical infrastructure projects and resolve delays or bottlenecks.



### ■ Programme Implementation:

- Ensure timely and efficient execution of government schemes and missions.



### ■ Grievance Redressal:

- Address persistent public grievances by integrating with systems like **Centralised Public Grievance Redressal and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS)** for citizen complaints.



## Key Achievements



377 projects have been reviewed under PRAGATI, and across these projects, 2,958 out of 3,162 identified issues - i.e. around 94% have been resolved.



Several projects that had remained stalled for decades were completed or decisively unlocked after being taken up under the PRAGATI platform.
