## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION - 7 SMART CITIES OF KARNATAKA



### BENGALURU



The state capital and India's IT hub, focusing on smart mobility, an Integrated Command & Control Centre (ICCC), and the redevelopment of central areas like Cubbon Park and KR Market.



### BELAGAVI



A major focus on smart transportation, heritage conservation, and upgraded public markets.

### DAVANAGERE



Prioritises water body rejuvenation (notably Kunduvada Kere), smart water management, and public space upgrades.

### HUBBALLI-DHARWAD



Features a Green Mobility Corridor for non-motorised transport and digital libraries.



### MANGALURU



Focuses on waterfront development along the Gurupura River, smart health facilities, and resilient coastal infrastructure.



### SHIVAMOGGA



Known for its 'Liveable Green City' vision, with riverfront projects and solar power initiatives.

### TUMAKURU



Developing as an industrial satellite town with smart classrooms, public bicycle sharing, and historic lake rejuvenation.
