52nd G-7 Summit: Key Topics Discussed

Topic	Key Discussion Points
 Economic Security	Focus on countering non-market policies, strengthening supply chains, and protecting critical technologies.
 AI Governance	Agreement on ensuring AI safety, establishing a semiconductor connection group, and bridging the digital divide.
 Support for Ukraine	Commitment to continued military support, maintaining energy stability, and upholding sanctions on Russian oil.
 Middle East	Discussions on Indo-Pacific stability, providing humanitarian support to Gaza, and addressing nuclear threats from Iran.
 Global Health	Emphasis on strengthening the Pandemic Fund, enhancing immunization, and combating Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR).
 Food Security	Support for the Apulia Food Initiative and the Nairobi-Washington vision for debt management.
