



52nd G-7 Summit: Key Declarations and Resolutions



Declaration	Key Resolutions
 Development Finance	Commitment to mobilizing private capital and strengthening the 3-pillar approach of the IMF and World Bank.
 3-Pillar Approach	Focused on structural reforms and financial support to reduce the debt burden on developing and underdeveloped nations.
 Ebola Control	Commitment to strict international action to contain the Bundibugyo Ebola outbreak in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Uganda.
 Cancer Control	Commitment to advancing cancer research, reducing mortality rates from lung cancer, and improving data availability for pediatric cancer.
 Geopolitics	Support for a free and open Indo-Pacific region; expressed deep concern over the nuclear programs of Iran and North Korea.
 Migrant Smuggling	Commitment to taking strict legal action against human trafficking networks, including collaboration with online platforms.
 Drug Trafficking	Establishment of the 'G-7+ Ports Network' to curb maritime drug trafficking and illegal financial flows.
