PM-UDAY Scheme Government Schemes



In News

- Recently Delhi CM has sought ₹100 crore as a first phase central government financial assistance to implement the revised **Pradhan Mantri Unauthorised Colonies in Delhi Awas Adhikar Yojana (PM-UDAY)** in the national capital.

Pradhan Mantri –Unauthorised Colonies in Delhi Awas Adhikar Yojana (PM-UDAY)

- Financing** - It is a central sector initiative
- Launched in-** October 2019
- Objective** - to grant legal ownership, transfer, and mortgage rights to residents living in Delhi's unauthorised colonies.
- Administered by** - Delhi Development Authority (DDA) under the **Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA)**,

Parrot Bornavirus 4 Science & technology



Context

- Deadly bird virus PaBV-4** has been identified for the first time in India.

Parrot Bornavirus 4 (PaBV-4)

- It is an avian virus recently detected for the first time in India (Assam, Karnataka, West Bengal) among captive parrot species.
- The Virus:** Enveloped, negative-sense, single-stranded RNA virus (Bornaviridae family).
- Zoonotic Status:** Not zoonotic (does not infect humans).
- Target:** Psittacine birds (macaws, cockatoos, parakeets, budgerigars).

Associated Disease

- It causes **Proventricular Dilatation Disease (PDD)**, also called "Macaw Wasting Disease."
- Gastrointestinal:** Destroys nerves in the digestive tract, causing an enlarged stomach, weight loss, and undigested seeds in droppings.

- **Neurological:** Causes tremors, loss of coordination, seizures, and paralysis.

Transmission & Management

- **Spread:** Contact with **infected feces, saliva, feather dust, or vertically from parent to egg.**
- **Challenge:** Infected birds can stay asymptomatic while actively shedding the virus.
- **Control:** **No vaccine or cure exists.** Diagnosis is via RT-PCR; management relies on isolation and supportive care.

India-New Zealand 'Strategic Partnership' International



News -

- The Prime Minister's visit to Auckland was the **first visit by an Indian Prime Minister to New Zealand in four decades.**
- PM Modi was honoured with a **Māori Pōwhiri**, a formal welcome ceremony of the Māori (the indigenous Polynesian people of New Zealand), featuring the 'Haka' dance.

Outcomes of the Visit

- **Roadmap to 2030:** Elevated bilateral relations to a 'Strategic Partnership'.
- **Indo-Pacific Oceans Initiative:** New Zealand adopted Maritime Security as its priority pillar within the seven-pillar IPOI framework.

- **Climate and Energy Platforms:** New Zealand joined the **Global Biofuels Alliance** and reaffirmed its cooperation under the **Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure (CDRI).**
- **Civilisational Ties:** Established cultural and traditional medicine cooperation alongside a **framework between the New Zealand Maritime Museum and India's National Maritime Heritage Complex at Lothal.**

New Zealand



- **Island Nation:** New Zealand is a **remote island country in the South Pacific Ocean**, consisting of two main islands (North and South) and several smaller islands.
- **No Land Borders**, and **Australia is its nearest neighbour**, located over 1,600 km to the northwest.
- **Geopolitical Position:** It lies in **Australasia** with **Australia** and marks the **southwestern boundary of Polynesia**, bordered by the Tasman Sea and the Pacific Ocean.

India's Textile Sector Economy



Context -

- The Ministry of Textiles released a report on India's Textile Future, emphasising the need to adopt circular economy principles across the textile value chain.

Significance of the Textile Sector

- It is also called the “spinning wheel” of India's industrial growth,
- The textile and apparel sector **contributes ~2% to GDP and ~11% of manufacturing GVA.**
- It is **India's 2nd largest employer after agriculture**, providing livelihoods to over 45 million people.
- **India is the 6th largest textile and apparel exporter**, with a 4% global market share.

Government Initiatives

- **PM MITRA Parks:** Massive textile parks with sustainable infrastructure, featuring Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs) to optimize water reuse.
- **National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM):** Funds scientific research to

chemically and mechanically convert tough textile waste into industrial advanced materials.

- **Eco Mark Scheme:** Establishes national eco-labelling standards for textile products, easing the transition into markets with strict environmental standards.
- **Mission LiFE:** Promotes clothing reuse, swapping, circular economies, and less fast-fashion consumption through lifestyle change.

Pinaka Long Range Guided Rocket Science & technology



News -

- **DRDO conducted a successful flight test of the Pinaka Long Range Guided Rocket (LRGR)** at the Integrated Test Range (ITR), Chandipur.

Pinaka Long Range Guided Rocket (LRGR)

- It is an **indigenously developed, precision-guided rocket for the Pinaka multi-barrel rocket launcher (MBRL) system.**
- It is designed to replace Russian-origin BM-21 Grad systems.
- **Range: Up to 120 km**
- **Guidance System:** It combines an **Inertial Navigation System (INS)** with **India's NavIC (IRNSS) satellite network** for precision navigation.

Oxytocin

Science & technology

Context -

- **WHO** has sought information from India regarding reports linking suspected spurious oxytocin to maternal deaths.

Oxytocin

- It is a **neuropeptide hormone** synthesised in the **hypothalamus** and released into the bloodstream by the posterior pituitary gland.
- Often called the “**love hormone**.”
- **Function** - It acts as a **chemical messenger** in the **central nervous system**, aiding childbirth, lactation, and social bonding.
- **Regulation** - Administering oxytocin to cattle is a cognizable offence under Section 12 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act; unauthorised manufacture or sale is prohibited under Section 18(a) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

UMANG Portal

Government Schemes



Context

- Researchers have identified security vulnerabilities in India's UMANG Portal, raising concerns about personal data.

UMANG (Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance)

- It was **launched in November 2017**.
- It is a flagship initiative **under the Digital India Programme**.

- It offers a **single window access** to a **wide range of services** delivered by the **Central Government, State Governments and local bodies** through a unified mobile application.
- **Significance** - It enables citizens to access services such as **EPFO, healthcare, pensions, LPG bookings, certificates**, and several other citizen-centric services through a single platform.
- As of February 2026, **UMANG offers 2,446 services from 240 government departments**, including 80 Central Government Departments and 160 departments across 30 States and Union Territories.
- **UMANG supports 23 Indian languages**, including **Hindi, English, Nepali, and Sanskrit**.

Standing Deposit Facility (SDF)

Economy

News

- The Reserve Bank of India(RBI) absorbed 1.67 lakh crore rupees through the Standing Deposit Facility (SDF).

Standing Deposit Facility (SDF)

- It is a **collateral-free RBI tool** used to absorb excess liquidity from banks.

Core Features

- **No collateral:** Banks park funds without RBI giving government
- **Urjit Patel Committee:** First recommended the tool in 2014.

Other Monetary Policy Tools in India

- **Repo Rate:** Rate at which RBI lends short-term funds to banks against collateral.
- **Reverse Repo Rate:** Rate at which RBI absorbs liquidity from banks.
- **Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR):** Portion of deposits banks must keep with RBI in cash.

- **Statutory Liquidity Ratio (SLR):** Portion of deposits kept in liquid assets (gold, cash, securities).
- **Open Market Operations (OMO):** Buying/selling of government securities to control liquidity.
- **Marginal Standing Facility (MSF):** Emergency borrowing by banks at a penal rate.
- **Liquidity Adjustment Facility (LAF):** Framework for repo/reverse repo operations.
- **Market Stabilisation Scheme (MSS):** Bonds issued to absorb excess liquidity.

Sulphur dioxide (SO₂) **Environment**

Context

- As per the study, nearly 81 per cent of **sulphur dioxide (SO₂) emissions from coal plants within a 300-km radius of Delhi-NCR** originate from facilities exempted from installing pollution control systems.

Sulfur dioxide (SO₂)

- It is a colorless, pungent, and toxic gas.
- **Primary Source:** Coal-fired thermal power plants.
- **Natural Source:** Volcanic eruptions and geothermal activity.
- **India Status:** Top global anthropogenic SO₂ emitter.
- **Health Impact:** Causes severe respiratory diseases (asthma).
- **Environment:** Precursor to acid rain.
- **Note - Sulfur dioxide is not a greenhouse gas.** While it is a major air pollutant with significant environmental impacts, it actually has a cooling effect on the Earth's climate rather than a warming one

Global Liveability Index 2026 **Syllabus: Miscellaneous**

Context

- The Economist Intelligence Unit has released the Global Liveability Index 2026.

Major Highlights

- **Published by** - The index is compiled annually by the **Economist Intelligence Unit**, the research and analysis arm of The Economist Group,
- It evaluated 173 cities across 30 indicators
- **Five categories:** Stability, healthcare, culture and environment, education, and infrastructure.
- **Copenhagen (Denmark) remains the world's most liveable city**, edging out **Vienna (Austria)** and **Melbourne (Australia)**, which are in second and third place.
- **New Delhi is ranked 120**, followed by **Mumbai (121)**, **Chennai (123)**, and **Bengaluru (127)**.
- Karachi stayed pinned at 170th place two years consecutively, Dhaka held at 171st, **Damascus (Syria) remains the world's least liveable city for a second consecutive year.**

Version 2026-1 of the IUCN Red List

News -

- The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) released the updated version 2026-1 of its Red List of Threatened Species.

About-

- IUCN Red List now covers 175,909 species, of which 49,505 (approximately 28%) are classified as threatened with extinction.

IUCN Red List

- IUCN Red List is the **most comprehensive inventory of the global extinction risk of animal, plant, and fungal species**, maintained by the Species Survival Commission.
- **Species are placed in nine categories:** Not Evaluated, Data Deficient, Least Concern, Near Threatened, Vulnerable, Endangered, Critically Endangered, Extinct in the Wild, and Extinct.

International Union of Conservation of Nature

- Establishment - 1948.

- Set up in - Gland, Switzerland.
- Objective - To promote international cooperation and to provide scientific knowledge and tools to aid conservation action.
- IUCN Red List - It established the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species in 1964.

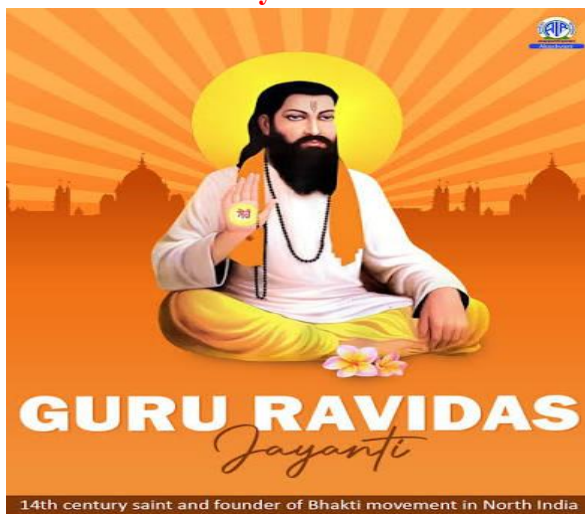
IUCN Red List

- It is a list compiled by the IUCN, which contains the world's most comprehensive information on the conservation status of plants, animals, and fungus species.
- Species in the IUCN Red List - There are 143000 species on the Red List.
- India's membership in IUCN - India became a member in 1969
- The IUCN classification - The IUCN classification of species is based on their extinction/conservation status.

They are as follows

- Extinct (EX)
- Extinct in the Wild (EW)
- Critically Endangered (CR)
- Endangered (EN), Vulnerable (VU)
- Near Threatened (NT)
- Least Concern (LC)
- Data Deficient (DD)
- Not Evaluated (NE)

Ravidassia Demand for Separate Religion History & Culture



News -

- The Ravidassia community has renewed its demand for creation of a separate “Ravidassia religion” category in the Census.

Ravidassia Community

- The community follows the teachings of **Guru Ravidas (15th–16th century)**, a renowned **Bhakti Movement saint**, social reformer, and mystic poet.
- **Core Philosophy:** Guru Ravidas advocated social equality, dignity, and the abolition of caste discrimination, and envisioned **Begampura**, an ideal society free from sorrow, fear, and inequality.
- **Population:** Punjab has India's largest concentration of Ravidassias in India and around 32% of the state's population comprises Dalits.
- **Major Institution:** **Dera Sachkhand Ballan (Punjab)** founded in the early 20th century by **Baba Sant Pipal Das** is the most influential religious institution of the Ravidassia community.

Additional Information - Sant Ravidas

- He, born in the 14th century,
- He was a prominent figure in the **Bhakti Movement**, a socio-religious revolution that took place in India between the 14th and 17th centuries.
- He was a disciple of Sant Kabir and the founder of the Ravidassia religion. Mirabai was his pupil.

Life and Teachings

- He was a great social reformer and messenger of peace, love, and brotherhood.
- He worked tirelessly to remove caste and religion-based discrimination and worked for the upliftment of the downtrodden.
- His life is a unique example of sacrifice and penance, and wrote many compositions on different social issues.

- He gave a very broad message of 'karma' to society by coining in the popular Hindi saying 'Mann Changa to Kathauti Mein Ganga'.

Legacy

- The Sikh scripture, **Guru Granth Sahib**, contains forty-one of his devotional songs and poems.
- The Chief Architect of our Constitution, **Dr. B.R. Ambedkar** embodied the Constitutional principles around the values expressed by **Guru Ravidasji**.

India Bans Imports of Goods Made Using Forced Labour Polity

Context

- The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has officially amended India's Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023, authorizing the **Central Government to ban imports of goods manufactured through forced labour**.

Constitutional Framework

The Constitution of India strictly penalises forced labour under the **Right against Exploitation**:

- **Article 23(1)** abolishes not just forced physical labor, but also economic subjugation, such as paying less than the minimum wage for labor
- **Article 23(2)** permits the State to draft individuals for essential public services (e.g., military conscription or disaster relief), but strictly forbids discrimination on the grounds of religion, race, caste, or class in the selection process.
- **Article 24**: Prohibits the employment of children below 14 years in factories, mines, or hazardous occupations.
- **Directive Principles (DPSC)**: **Article 42** mandates just and humane working conditions, while **Article 43** commands the state to secure a living wage.

Trial in Absentia Polity

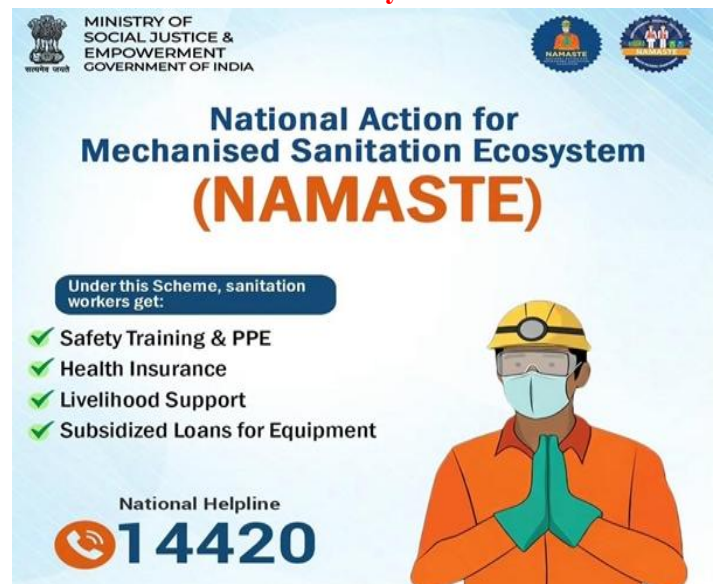
News

- **Lashkar-e-Taiba chief Hafiz Saeed is set to face a trial in absentia** following the issuance of a non-bailable warrant by a special NIA court in Jammu for his role in the 2025 Pahalgam terror attack.

About -

- A trial in absentia under **Section 356 of the BNSS, 2023**, allows any competent trial court to conduct a criminal trial and pronounce judgment without the physical presence of the accused.
- **CrPC, 1973**, restricted courts to recording witness statements only when the accused absconded, whereas the **BNSS permits a final verdict**.
- **Eligibility**: The provision applies exclusively to proclaimed offenders declared under **Section 84** for offences punishable with 10 years, life imprisonment, or death.
- The **Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023** officially replaced the colonial-era Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC), 1973, taking effect on **July 1, 2024**.

Context

- The Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment celebrated the 3rd **NAMASTE Day on July 14**, marking three years since the launch of the **National Action for Mechanized Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE) Scheme in 2023**.

NAMASTE Day

- It is dedicated to **honouring sanitation workers including sewer and septic tank workers, waste pickers and former manual scavengers** for their vital role in safeguarding public health and environmental sanitation.

National Action for Mechanised Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE)

- **Launched in - July 2023**
- **Financing - Central Sector Scheme**
- **Implemented by - Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs,**

Objectives:

- Zero fatalities in sanitation work.
- All sanitation operations to be performed by skilled workers.
- No direct contact with human faecal matter.
- Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers.

Key Interventions:

- **Profiling:** Digital profiling of Sewer/Septic Tank Workers (SSWs).
- **Safety:** Providing PPE kits, safety devices, and training to workers.
- **Empowerment:** Capital subsidy for purchasing sanitation machinery to become "sanipreneurs".
- **Health:** Occupational safety training and health insurance.
- **Significance:** Aligns with **SDG 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation)** and promotes the dignity and safety of sanitation workers.

Mobile Phone Manufacturing Scheme (MPMS) Economy

In News

- The Union Cabinet approved a new **Mobile Phone Manufacturing Scheme (MPMS)** with a budgetary outlay of **₹62,500 crore**.

Objective -

- It has been launched to **scale up domestic production, deepen component localization, and foster indigenous smartphone design and R&D**.
- **Launched by:** It has been launched by **Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)**.
- **Duration:** It is a five-year scheme, which will run from **FY 2026-27 to FY 2030-31**.
- **Budget Outlay:** Its budgetary outlay is of **Rs. 62,500 crore**.

Features

- **Production-Linked Incentives:** The scheme provides incentive support on eligible sales of mobile phones manufactured in India, with differentiated incentive rates ranging from 2.25% to 5%, based on the applicable eligibility criteria.
- **Incentive for Domestic Value Addition:** Manufacturers can receive an additional incentive of up to 1.5% for increasing domestic sourcing of key components and sub-assemblies, thereby promoting local manufacturing ecosystems.
- **Support for Design and Innovation:** To foster indigenous innovation and brand creation, the scheme offers an additional 3% incentive on eligible sales for companies undertaking product design and R&D activities in India.

Semicon 2.0 Economy



Context

- The Union Cabinet approved Semicon 2.0 (India Semiconductor Mission 2.0) with a ₹1,27,500 crore outlay to develop India's semiconductor ecosystem.

Six Strategic Pillars:

1. Design:
2. Machines & Materials:
3. Fabrication:
4. Expanding Assembly, Testing, Marking, and Packaging (ATMP) and Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test (OSAT) units to establish India as a global alternative.
5. R&D
6. Talent Development

India Semiconductor Mission (ISM)

- Launched by - Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.
- Aim - To build a vibrant semiconductor manufacturing ecosystem to enable India's emergence as a global hub for electronics manufacturing and design.

Connect with the basics - Semiconductor Chips

- These are materials which have a **conductivity between conductors and insulators**.
- **Example** - They can be pure elements, **silicon or germanium** or compounds; gallium, arsenide or cadmium selenide.
- **Significance of Semiconductor Chips** - They are the basic building blocks that serve as the **heart and brain of all modern electronics** and information and communication technology products.
- **Applications** - These chips are now an integral part of contemporary **automobiles, household gadgets and essential medical devices** such as ECG machines.

12th BRICS Labour & Employment Ministers' Meeting International



Context -

- India hosted the 12th BRICS Labour & Employment Ministers' Meeting in Hyderabad.

- **Theme 2026 - “Building for Resilience, Innovation, Cooperation and Sustainability”.**

Outcomes -

- **BRICS Labour and Employment Ministers’ Declaration** - to promote decent work, broaden social protection systems, and support inclusive, resilient economic growth.
- **BRICS CONNECT**, a collaborative, tech-driven platform, was launched by India to modernise, align, and strengthen labour frameworks (South-South cooperation) across member states.

Additional Information - BRICS

- **Founded in** - 2009
- **HeadQuarters** - Shanghai
- It is an acronym for the grouping of the world’s leading emerging economies, namely **Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa (included in 2010)**
- **Origin** - The term “**BRIC**” was coined by the **British Economist Jim O’Neill** in 2001 to describe the four emerging economies of **Brazil, Russia, India, and China.**
- **Recent Expansion (BRICS+):** In 2024–2025, the bloc expanded to include **Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, the UAE, and Indonesia.** Saudi Arabia has received an invitation but has not yet formalized its membership.
- **Share of BRICS** - BRICS brings together five of the largest developing countries, representing **41% of the global population, 24% of the global GDP, and 16% of the global trade** (By 2028, BRICS is expected to make up 35 percent of the global economy)
- **Chairmanship** - The chairmanship of the forum is rotated annually among the members.

Initiatives of BRICS

1. New Development Bank (NDB)
2. Contingent Reserve Arrangement (CRA)
3. BRICS Payment System
4. Customs Agreements

5. Constellation of Remote Sensing Satellites

Jagannath Rath Yatra Art & Culture



Context

- The world-famous Rath Yatra of Lord Jagannath has commenced in Puri, Odisha.

Rath Yatra

- Known as - Gundicha Jatra, Ghosa Jatra and Navadina Jatra.
- It is a significant Hindu festival dedicated to Lord Jagannath, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu.

Jagannath Puri Temple

- Shree Jagannath Puri Temple is one of the most impressive monuments of the State of Odisha.
- The temple was built in the 12th Century AD by King Anatavarman Chodaganga Deva of the Eastern Ganga Dynasty.
- Jagannath Puri temple is called ‘Yamanika Tirtha’ where, according to the Hindu beliefs, the power of ‘Yama’, the god of death has been nullified in Puri due to the presence of Lord Jagannath, popularly known as Lord Krishna.
- It is one of the Dhammas (Holiest of the holy place) out of four Dhamas i.e. Puri, Dwarika, Badrinath & Rameswar, in India.
- This temple was called the “White Pagoda” and is a part of Char Dham pilgrimages (Badrinath, Dwaraka, Puri, Rameswaram).

7th Governing Body Meeting of National CAMPA Environment

News -

- The 7th Governing Body Meeting of National CAMPA in Coimbatore marked a **shift from conventional compensatory afforestation toward landscape-based ecological restoration.**

Outcomes -

- **Aastha Van Sanrakshan Yojana (AVSY)** was approved with an initial corpus of ₹3,000 crore (2026–31) to **conserve nearly 15,000 sacred groves (Aastha Vans).**
- **MISHTI (Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats and Tangible Incomes)** was **extended for three years until 2029**, with an added ₹500 crore, taking the total outlay to ₹600 crore.

Four wildlife recovery programmes were approved

- **Objective** - to strengthen scientific monitoring, anti-poaching measures, and habitat restoration:
- **Gangetic Dolphins:** Recovery action plan focused on major freshwater river systems.
- **Project Snow Leopard Phase-II:** Including the 2nd nationwide population estimate in the Himalaya.
- **Indian Rhinoceros:** Conservation plan for habitat protection and anti-poaching enforcement.
- **Wild Water Buffalo:** Scientific habitat management to secure the remaining population.
- **Sangai (Brow-antlered Deer):** Continued financial and operational support for conservation.

Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management & Planning Authority (CAMPA)

- It was established under the **Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 (in force 2018).**

- **Objective** - to collect and administer funds for ecological compensation of diverted forest land.
- **Genesis:** Supreme Court, in **T.N. Godavarman, constituted an ad hoc CAMPA by its 2006** order to manage unspent afforestation collections.
- **Two Tiers: (1) National CAMPA Authority**, headed by the Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, sets policy, while **(2) State CAMPA Authorities execute field operations.**
- **Liability:** Agencies diverting forest land must provide alternative land, fund compensatory afforestation, and pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of the lost forest ecosystem.
- **Fund Uses:** **Artificial and natural regeneration, wildlife management, catchment treatment, village relocation** from protected areas, and human-wildlife conflict management.

Cyclosporiasis Science & Technology

News -

- **A widespread outbreak of cyclosporiasis has been reported in the United States.**

About -

- **Responsible pathogen-** Cyclosporiasis is a foodborne **intestinal illness caused by the microscopic, single-celled protozoan parasite Cyclospora cayetanensis.**
- **Transmission:** Strictly fecal-oral route via contaminated food or water.
- **No Direct Person-to-Person Spread:** Excreted parasite eggs require days to weeks in the environment to mature and become infectious.
- **Host Range:** **Humans are the only known hosts.**
- **Symptoms:** Severe, explosive watery diarrhea, fatigue, cramps, and weight loss.

- **High-Risk Groups:** Immunocompromised individuals, the elderly, and young children.
- **Diagnosis:** Missed by routine stool cultures; requires special staining, **UV fluorescence microscopy, or PCR.**
- **Treatment:** Treated with the **antibiotic trimethoprim-sulfamethoxazole (TMP-SMX).** No vaccine exists.

News -
