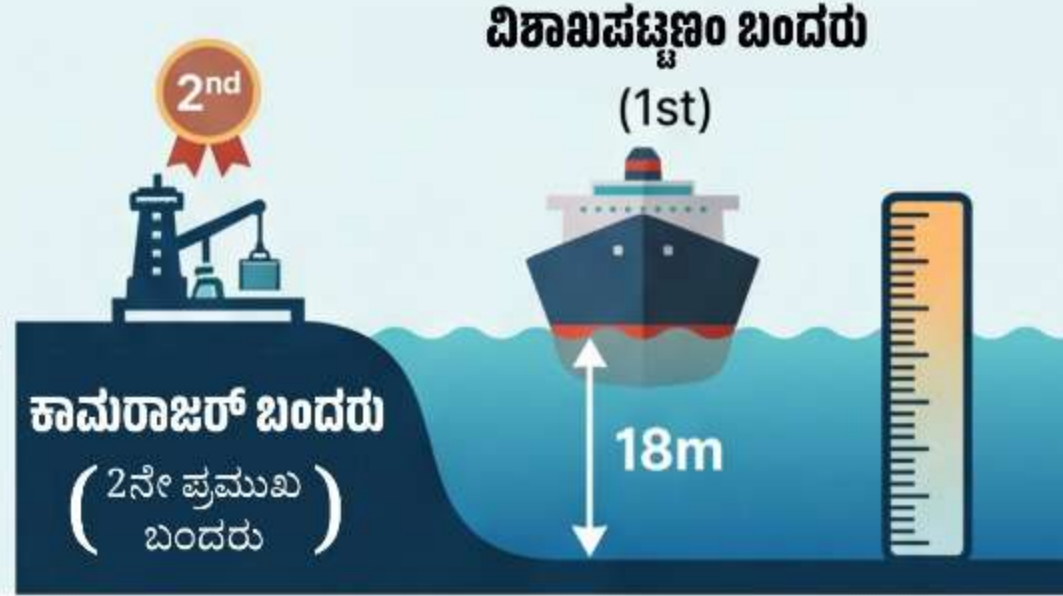


# Kamarajar Port

## In News

- Kamarajar Port became the second Major Port of India, after Visakhapatnam Port, to offer a draft capability of 18 metres.



## Kamarajar Port



- It is a deep-water port with cargo carrying capacity of up to 1,70,000 deadweight tonnage (DWT).



- Formerly Known as Ennore Port



- Major Ports:** There are 14 major ports (12 Operational) under administrative control of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways.

- India has 14 major ports, out of which 12 are fully operational.
